We are grateful to **Berndt Schmit, MD**, for his exemplary leadership in founding our emergency radiology service






RESIDENT EXCELLENCE








Studying abroad had to be a wonderful experience. Will you share a favorite memory?

You have quickly become an integral part of the team, working as Executive Assistant! Where were you before Medical Imaging?

I came to DMI from the COM-T Development team. I enjoyed my experience working with teams across disciplines to fund their initiatives.

Are you from Tucson, originally?

I moved to Tucson from Illinois where I worked in public education and in healthcare and raised 4 children.

Will you talk about your training prior to coming to the University of Arizona?

My degree is in Speech Communication from the University of Illinois, Urbana-Champaign. I also trained as an actor and studied English Literature and Theater Arts at the University of Warwick in Coventry, England.

I was in the Soviet Union in March of 1985, having joined a trip with the Russian History department. During our visit, Chernenko died. While that was sad, certainly, the main impact on our group was that we weren't allowed to leave our hotel (which was on the funeral procession route), or go near the windows, lest the security forces think we were snipers. Finally able to go outdoors, I distinctly recall a Russian gentleman who stopped me, and began to gesture toward my Birkenstock-clad feet. "Amerikanskaya? Amerikanskaya?" he asked. He was clearly surprised that an American couldn't afford boots, and walked off shaking his head.




