Diversity! As a radiologist, we see so many different types of cases in one day than any other doctor may see in a month. You are always solving a "puzzle," and there are plenty of them.


Radiologists, to me, are the heart of a hospital because all the other departments are connected to us in one way or another.

Neuroradiology fellowship at Johns Hopkins University




